The fact that he didn't attend the meeting surprised everyone.
(彼が会議に出席しなかったことは皆を驚かせた)

→ 文構造がわからず戻って読んでしまう

#### 戻り読みゼロチャレンジ

戻り読みの原因となる5大要因(that節,接続詞,関係代名詞,分詞,同格)を区別するクイズ。



#### 戻り読みゼロチャレンジの例

Q. 次の文の that は「that節」と「関係代名詞」のどちらですか?

I know that she is coming to the party.

A) that節

B) 関係代名詞

正解: A) that節

訳: 彼女がパーティーに来ることは知っています。



## ①that節とは?

「that + 主語 + 動詞」の形で、文の一部として使われる節。 動詞の目的語や主語になることが多い。

The manager / said / [that / the project / was / successful]. (マネージャーはプロジェクトが成功したと言った)



# ②接続詞とは?

単語や文をつなぐ言葉。

The meeting / was postponed / <because / the CEO / was / unavailable>. (CEOが不在だったので, 会議は延期された)



# 等位接続詞

対等な関係の語や文をつなぐ

She / can speak / [English and French]. (彼女は英語とフランス語を話せる)



#### 從属接続詞

主節と従属節(補足情報を加える節)をつなぐ

She / stayed / home / <until / the rain / stopped>.
(雨が止むまで彼女は家にいた)



# ③関係代名詞とは?

名詞を詳しく説明する節を導く語

The book / [that / she / recommended] / was / very interesting. (彼女が勧めた本はとても面白かった)



## ④分詞とは?

動詞を変化させて形容詞のように使うもの

The documents / (signed / by the director) / need / to be filed. (取締役が署名した書類は保管する必要がある)



#### ⑤同格とは?

名詞を補足説明する別の名詞, または節。 カンマで区切られることが多い

My colleague, / an experienced designer, / suggested / a new concept. (同僚の経験豊富なデザイナーが新しいコンセプトを提案した)



#### "戻り読み5大要因"まとめ

that節	The manager said that the project was successful.
接続詞	The meeting was postponed because the CEO was unavailable.
関係代名詞	The book that she recommended was very interesting.
分詞	The documents signed by the director need to be filed.
同格	My colleague, an experienced designer, suggested a new concept.
